When the COVID-19 lockdown began, millions of children transitioned to online learning. However, in India's tribal regions, this shift left children behind due to a lack of smartphones, computers, and internet access. Many lost years of progress in literacy and numeracy.

OUR RESPONSE

JANPATH initiated the "Falia Learning Center" to address this learning crisis. Inspired by our success with the Rann Shala Digital Learning Programme, we brought hope and education to some of the most underserved communities in the Danta block of Banaskantha district.

PERSONALIZED LEARNING

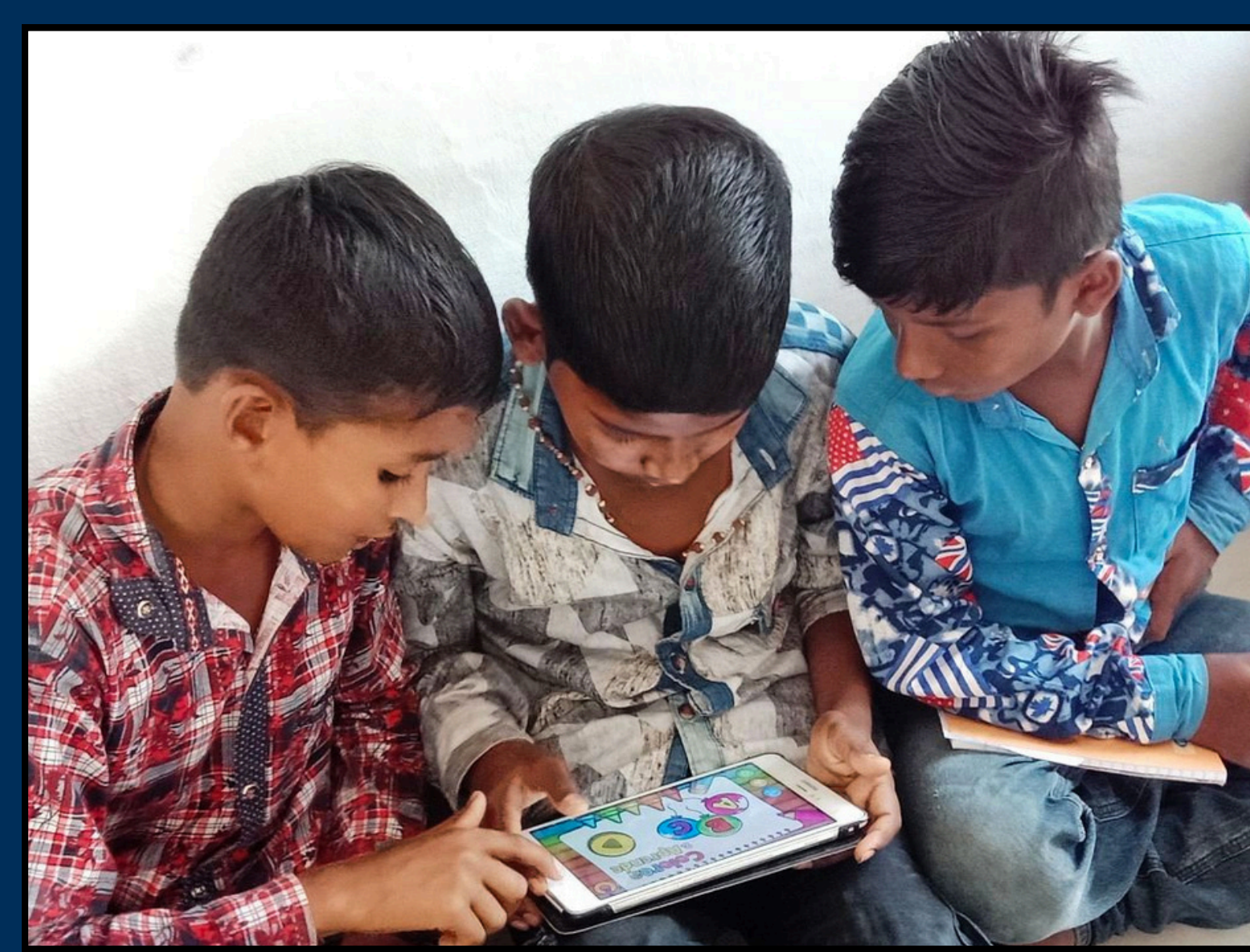

SUPPORTIVE INITIATIVES

EMPOWERING NOT JUST CHILDREN BUT THEIR FAMILIES AND COMMUNITIES

- Assisted 95% of children in returning to school, rebuilding trust in education.
- Supported 800+ households in accessing essential government schemes, ensuring that basic needs like food and pensions are met.
- Provided school supplies (notebooks, uniforms, shoes) to 5,500 children, eliminating financial barriers to learning.
- Enhanced Mid-Day Meals with community donations of sweets and vegetables, nurturing both bodies and minds.
- Introduced vegetable gardens in schools, teaching self-reliance and sustainability while improving nutrition.

SPECIAL EVENTS AND PROJECTS

INSPIRING MINDS THROUGH DISCOVERY AND CELEBRATION

- **Organized:**

- Science Fairs and Balmelas (Fun Fairs): Sparked creativity and fostered friendships among children from different schools.
- Exposure Visits to Science City: Expanded children's horizons beyond their villages.

- **Infrastructure Initiatives:**

- Installed smartboards in 10 schools and established a cutting-edge science laboratory.
- Collaborated with the Vikram Sarabhai Science Center to bring advanced educational resources to remote villages.

THE WAY FORWARD

SCALING IMPACT AND BUILDING SUSTAINABILITY

1. Empowering Local Leadership: Train School Management Committees and village leaders to actively support their schools.
2. Expanding Outreach: Introduce the programme to the Poshina block, prioritizing villages with acute malnutrition and educational gaps.
3. Sustainability Initiatives: Develop vegetable gardens in every school and integrate water conservation practices to promote environmental stewardship.
4. Enhanced Advocacy: Strengthen ties with block, district, and state administration for improved school infrastructure and teacher support.
5. Long-Term Vision: Address systemic issues by creating sustainable models for education and community development.
